Is Mr Chrestomanci an enchanter, an inquisitor or just a school governor? Is Nan a witch? Or Brian? Or Charles? Is everyone a witch? Who does Miss Hodge love? Who is the Headteacher? Diana Wynne Jones is a very funny writer. Her plots are often very complicated. This one is no exception. The story races with wild abandon from one crisis to the next and leaves a breathless reader at the end. For bright, older middle school readers, still ready to slip into a world of magic but logical enough to unravel the plot as they go along.
