The unlikeliest of packages can contain the best goods. When I looked at the 'twee' cover of Kit, I could already feel the tide of nausea rising. How wrong could I be? Two extremely sensitive allegories of a girl's struggle to grow within the claustrophobic atmosphere and environmental limitations of moorland farm life are revealed through this compulsive little (only 107 pages) book. The second tale is particularly evocative, as the sensitive artist, 'Lonesome Jones', is silently mocked by Kit's farmer father whose often stated credo ('Work hard. There's nothing like it.') is the ethic by which he lives. The threat imposed to his 'philosophy' by the artist is fully justified as the story unfolds.
